PROGRAM ACHIEVEMENTS

12 teenage mothers imparted with life skills and provided with start-up kits to support their livelihoods activities

Encomium 2020 supported 12 teenage mothers in Buhweju district and trained them in essential life skills and livelihoods. They were also supported with milk and other essential food items for themselves and their babies; these had dropped out of school because of their parturition circumstances.

60 Psychosocial support sessions for communities

Psychosocial support sessions were facilitated to exert confidence and encourage active engagement, participation and sharing among community members on the common issues affecting them; learn to resolve conflicts and restore relations. Active community members were encouraged to connect with each other and create an open and free space to share their day-to-day challenges and successes to inspire others.

Other activities

- 30 home visits conducted for the follow up support for the teenage mothers
- Encomium 2020 signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Wakiso District for mutual support and full collaboration; Encomium 2020's head offices were officially opened in Wakiso.
- Encomium 2020 became incorporated with Limited Liability by the Uganda Registration
 Services Bureau (Reg. No: 80020002899490)
- Encomium 2020 was registered as a nongovernment organisation with the Uganda National Bureau for NGOs (Reg. No. INDR156804712NB)

FUTURE GOALS

Encomium 2020 acknowledges that Uganda is still battling the COVID-19 pandemic, though with significantly reduced infection rates. Given the threat from other disease outbreaks, other interventions including health and nutrition, and WASH have to be prepositioned for more people especially the children to ensure their health and safety. Since Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) is one of the sectors that have been greatly affected by a multitude of challenges, sustaining good hygiene practices through participation and mobilization among community members requires household contributions through available market-based approaches to counter the limited availability of services. Encomium 2020 intends to strengthen the capacity and abilities of communities to revamp the WASH infrastructure required for response practices that can help build future resilience. Long-term follow-up for the implemented interventions is important to ensure sustainability of the essential community behaviors and to reinforce hygiene messages and practices, to which Encomium 2020 is committed by leveraging inclusiveness of all community actors.
